How project managers work with Conode

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In the steering committee meeting
Quickly write down important information the second it comes up: *committed milestones, key stakeholders, potential impediments, top targets, ...*
Conode Notes work as **fast and as simple** like your paper notebook.



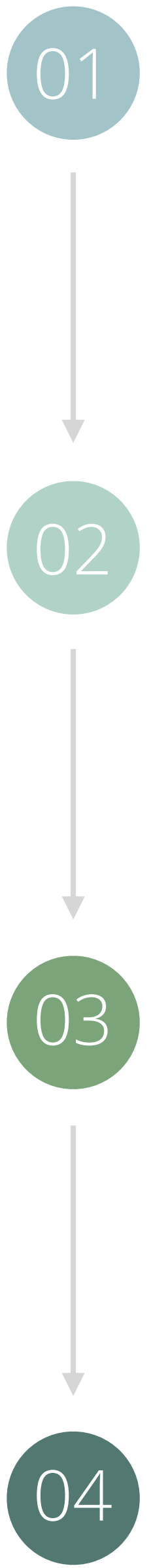
Back in your Cubicle
Screen your notes like using an analogue agenda: merge similar **Notes** to one single **Page**. Add new information: a photo, a sketch or a link. Then, let Conode's AI **categorise** your content in specific Topics through **smart tags**:
#steeringcommittee #milestones #minutes #goals



Bring your notes to life
Send your team an update: simply convert your content to an e-mail, a chat message or invite them to **collaborate**. And to make sure, the valuable insights don't get lost, create a task from single text blocks and **delegate** them to your colleagues. It's one workflow and a **great time saver**.



Push it to the productivity ecosystem
And since your co-workers are using a bunch of different tools, **easily push** the stream lead's tasks to Microsoft Office, the sales targets to Salesforce and sync the committed milestones the Asana project. This creates immediate **transparency** and a lot of **fewer**

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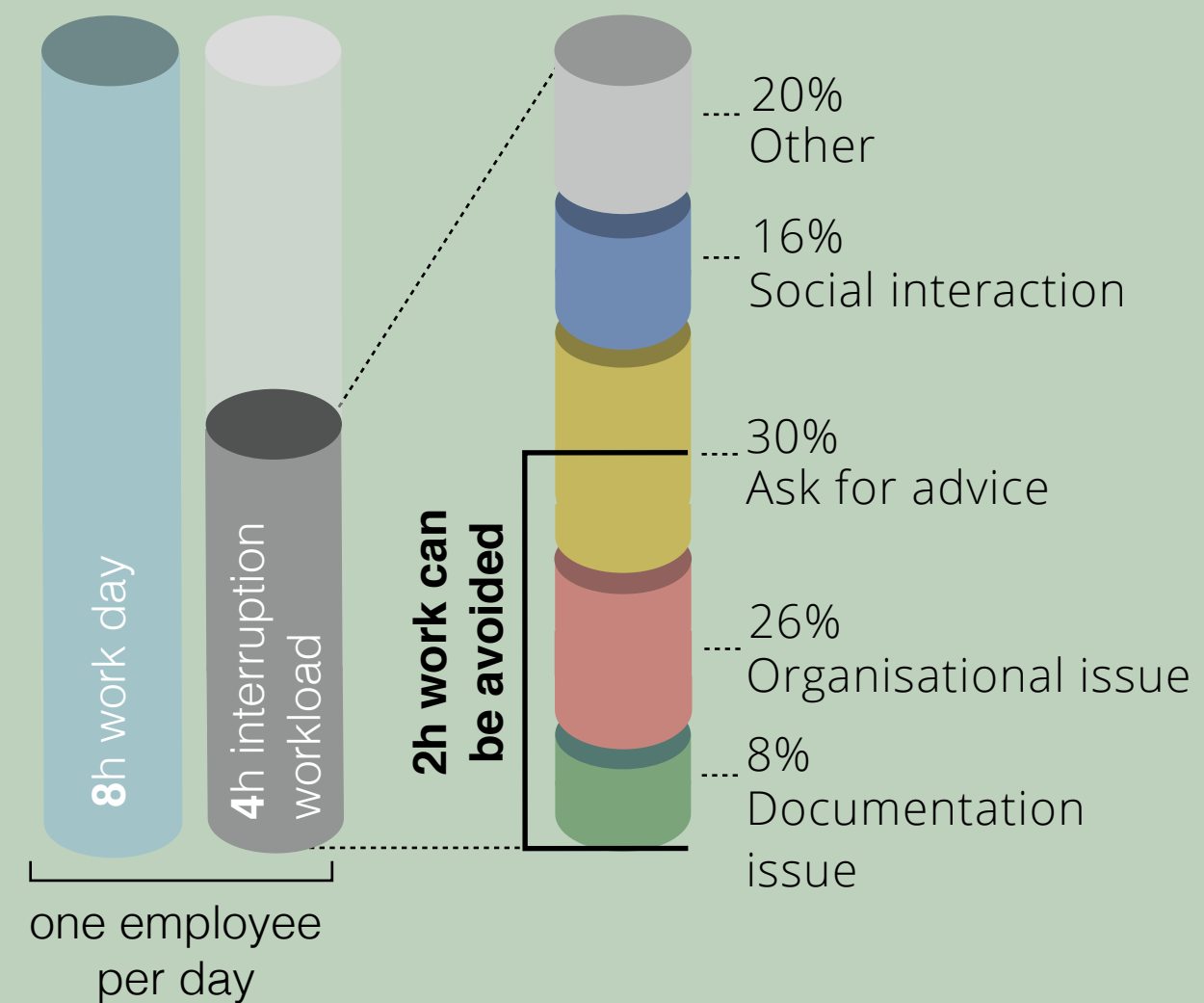
